




10 Best Du'as of the

A small guide to elevating your Du'as

- 1 Observing wudhu before making the Du'a (it's sunnah, not obligatory).
- 2 Facing the Qiblah (it's sunnah, not obligatory).
- 3 Raising one's hands towards Allah as a gesture of supplication.
- 4 Sending blessings upon the Prophet (PBUH) at the open and close of your Du'a.
- 5 Using Allah's beautiful names to invoke Him during Du'a.
- 6 Seeking repentance and forgiveness for sins and wrongdoings.
- 7 Sincerity and unwavering trust in Allah's (SWT) response.

*Dhahaba adh-Dhama'
wabtallatil-urooq
wa thabatal-ajr
insha'Allah*

رَبَّنَا إِنَّا أَمْنَا فَاغْفِرْ لَنَا
ذُنُوبَنَا وَقِنَّا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

*Rabbanaaa innanaaa
aamannaa faghfir
lanaazunoobanaa wa
qinaa 'azaaban Naar*

*Our Lord! Surely we believe, therefore
forgive us our faults and save us from
the chastisement of the fire.*

Du'a for protection

اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّا نَسْأَلُكَ رِضَاكَ وَالْجَنَّةَ
وَنَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ سَخَطِكَ وَالنَّارِ

*Allaahumma innee as-aluka
Ridaaka wal Jannah wa
a'audhu'bika min sakhatika
wan-naar*

*O Allah, I ask of Your pleasure and for
Paradise and I seek refuge from Your
displeasure and from the Hellfire.*

Du'a for divine guidance

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ الْهُدَىٰ،
وَالتَّقَىٰ، وَالْعِفَافَ، وَالغِنَىٰ

*Allahumma Inna As'aluka al-
Huda Wat-Tuqa Wal-Afafa
Wal-Ghina'*

O Allah, I ask You for guidance
and piety, and abstinence (from
the unlawful) and modesty, and
contentment and sufficiency.

Du'a for acceptance

رَبَّنَا تَقَبَّلْ مِنَّا إِنَّكَ
أَنْتَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ

*Rabbana taqabbal minna,
innaka antas-Sami'ul-
'Aleem.*

*Our Lord! Accept
(this service) from us. Verily!
You are the All-Hearer,
the All-Knower.*

*The following is a special Du'a
to recite on the Day of Arafah**

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ،
لَهُ الْمُلْكُ، وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ، وَهُوَ
عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

*Lailaha illalahu wahadahu
lasharikalahu lahumulku
walahu hamdu wahuwa alakulli
shayin kadir*

*There is no God but Allah alone Who
has no partner, to whom dominion
belongs, to whom praise is due, and
who has power over everything.*

* The best time to make Dua is during the
last hour before Maghrib prayer

*Du'a to recite on Eid al Adha**

الله أكبر، الله أكبر، لا إله إلا الله،
والله أكبر الله أكبر ولله الحمد

Allahu Akbar

*Allahu Akbar, Laa ilaaha
illallahu Wallahu Akbar, Allahu
Akbar, Wa lillahil Hamd*

*Allah is the greatest, Allah is the
greatest. There is no deity besides
Allah and Allah is the greatest.
Allah is the greatest and all praises
are for Allah only.*

* It is highly recommended for every Muslim adult to recite the Takbeer-e-Tashreeq after prayer from the 9th-13th Dhul Hijjah. Men should recite this out loud, while women should recite this silently.

There is no day on which Allah frees people from the Fire more so than on the day of 'Arafah. He comes close to those (people standing on 'Arafah), and then He reveals before His Angels saying, 'What are these people seeking.

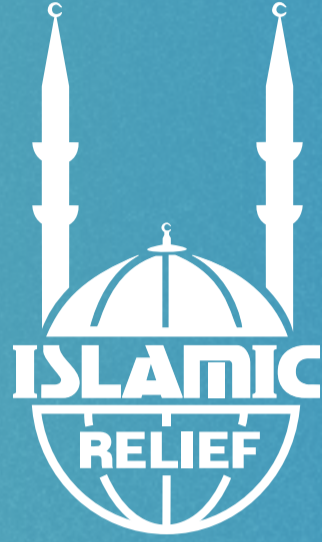
